Admission Requirements

Admission to the Master's Educational Program in Educational Research and Administration is open to individuals who hold a Bachelor's degree or an equivalent academic degree and have successfully passed both the Unified Master's Exam and the internal university entrance examinations.

Candidates are eligible to participate in the internal university examinations if they meet the minimum competency threshold for the Unified Master's Exam.

Applicants must take a written internal university examination (test) in English to confirm proficiency at a minimum B2 level and an oral examination (interview) in their specialty.



The topics/tests for internal university examinations and the student assessment criteria will be published on the university's official website at least one month before the examination begins (http://eeu.edu.ge).

Admission to the Master's Educational Program in Educational Research and Administration is also possible through student mobility, in accordance with current legislation. However, candidates applying through mobility must meet the program-specific admission requirements.

Enrollment in Master's program without passing the Unified Master's Exam is permitted under specific conditions set by the Ministry of Education, Science, and Youth of Georgia, within the timeframe and in accordance with the rules established under Article 52¹, Paragraphs 7 and 7¹ of the Law of Georgia on Higher Education.

Program structure:

The Master's Educational Program in Educational Research and Administration consists of academic coursework (90 ECTS) and a scientific research component (30 ECTS).

The academic coursework (90 ECTS) of the Master's Educational Program in Educational Research and Administration includes mandatory courses (60 ECTS), elective courses (18 ECTS), and reflective practice (12 ECTS).

Reflective Practice (12 ECTS) is an mandatory component of the Master's program, aimed at developing students' practical skills. Within this framework, students independently plan and implement practical activities in agreement with and under the supervision of a practice supervisor. Reflective practice takes place in partner organizations relevant to the field.

The scientific research component (30 ECTS) of the Master's Educational Program in Educational Research and Administration consists of the Master's Thesis
