

Rule for granting scholarships and incentives to EEU students



Approved by the order № 10 / 01-01 of April 28, 2022 of the Rector of the University

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Article 1. General Provisions

- 1. The "Rules for Issuing Scholarships and Incentives for Students" (hereinafter referred to as the "Rule") regulates the procedures for defining and issuing scholarships and other incentives for students of East European University LLC.
- **2.** The purpose of this rule is to increase student motivation, create a competitive environment, improve and promote student life.

Article 2. Types of Scholarships and Incentives

- 1. The University has:
 - a) University scholarships for undergraduate, integrated and postgraduate students;
 - b) Study grant;
 - c) Scholarships for excellent graduates;
 - d) One-time awards and other types of individual incentives;
- 2. The student will receive a university scholarship based on the results achieved each semester. The scholarship is valid for one semester and is defined in the amount of 600 (six hundred) GEL;
- 3. The training grant applies to the following target groups:
 - a) Socially vulnerable persons;
 - b) Foreign citizens of Georgian ethnic origin (Laz, Georgians from Fereydun, etc.);
 - c) Persons affected by natural disasters;
 - d) Other separate cases by the decision of the Rector;
- 4. An undergraduate student who has completed general education with a gold or silver medal will be awarded a University Scholarship for the duration of the program.
- 5. The student will be awarded a one-time prize for outstanding activity in university life (for example, representing the University in sports, cultural, intellectual competitions, exhibitions, scientific conferences, etc.).

6. The Rector of the University, on his / her own initiative or at the request of the faculty, student self-government, carries out various types of individual incentive activities that serve to improve student life and increase motivation;

Article 3. Scholarship Appointment Procedure and Assessment Criteria

- 1. Students are funded by the **University Scholarship** on the basis of the student's academic performance, active participation in student university activities and involvement in educational scientific activities;
- 2. University scholarship is not granted:
 - a) In case of termination of student status or award of a degree in the scholarship year;
 - b) For a student who moved with mobility in the spring / autumn semester of the previous academic year;
 - c) For an additional semester student;
 - d) For a student who has registered less credits than the number of credits defined by the educational program per semester;
- 3. Academic attendance is calculated in the number of courses registered by the student during the previous academic semester at the University according the weighted of grade point average (GPA).
- 4. Students with a semester **GPA** (grade point average) of **3.5 or higher** are eligible for the University Scholarship, according the 1st and 2nd Subsections of this Article; **The** minimum grade obtained in student university activities is not less than 2 points; **The** minimum grade for participation in educational-scientific activities is not less than 2 points.
- 5. The activity that will be carried out after the end of the semester and before the beginning of the new semester, the student will be considered as participating in the activity carried out in the previous semester.

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- 6. For the appointment of a university scholarship, the dean of the faculty determines the priority list of university and educational-scientific student activities and the awarded points.
- 7. University scholarships are awarded according to the ranking of points (maximum 4 points and minimum 3.05 points), *the criteria of which are set as follows:*
 - a) Academic performance scores are determined by weighted average scores GPA, which is multiplied by 0,7.
 - b) Student participation in student university activities (public lecture, seminar, culturaleducational events, etc.) is evaluated with a maximum of 4 points, which must be multiplied by 0.1.
 - c) Student participation in educational-scientific activities (conference, exchange projects, student projects, simulated processes, publications, etc.) is evaluated with a maximum of 4 points, which must be multiplied by 0.2.
- 8. Each semester registration of students in university and educational-scientific student activities is carried out by the relevant faculty. The Faculty shall establish a list of University Scholars, which shall be considered by the Department of Education in accordance with the criteria set forth in Article 3, paragraphs 2, 3, 4, 5, and 7 of this Rule. The final list of scholarship holders is approved by the order of the Rector.
- 9. **A study grant** for the educational programs of the University may be obtained by a member of each group referred to in paragraph 3 of Article 2 after applying to the Rector of the University and submitting the relevant documentation. The amount of the study grant is determined on a case-bycase basis, on the basis of a recommendation from the Dean of the Faculty, by order of the Rector;
- 10. Students who have completed general education with a gold or silver medal, **in order to obtain a scholarship for excellent school graduates**, must submit an application to the University rector within one month of enrollment in the university and submit a certificate or certificate of award issued by an authorized body.

- 11. By order of the Rector, scholarships will be awarded to graduate students with honors for the duration of the program if they have a GPA of 3.0 or higher each semester.
 - a) Gold Medal Student 20% tuition funding;
 - b) Silver Medal Student 10% tuition funding;
- **12. A one-time award** is given to a student for outstanding activity in university life (for example, representing the University in sporting, cultural, intellectual competitions, exhibitions, scientific conferences, etc.) and the Rector of the University, according the recommendation of the Student Self-Government President or the Faculty, determines the the recipient of the onetime award and the type of award.

Article 4. Final Provisions

- 1. This rule is approved by the Rector of the University on the basis of an order.
- 2. Changes in the rules for granting scholarships and incentives for students at East European University shall be made by order of the Rector of the University.
