


CLUBS

1. General Provisions

1. The present charter defines the powers, the main principles and goals of the Young Researchers Club (hereinafter - the "**Club**") at East European University LLC (hereinafter - the "**University**").
2. The student club of young researchers is a voluntary association of students and graduates around common educational-scientific interest/goals, which is formed on the basis of the university faculty in order to organize/improve educational-scientific work among students.
3. The club is established and functions in accordance with the rules established by the present charter.
4. The club has its own logo, contact e-mail and its own page on the official website of the university.
5. The Club Support and Development Council makes the decision on club creation/registration and cancellation.
6. The club is accountable to the Club Support and Development Council.
7. The club is guided in its activities by the legislation of Georgia, the regulations of the student club of the East European University, the present charter and other legal acts of the university..

2. Goals and objectives of the club

1. **The purpose of the club:**
 - a) A unified platform should be created at the faculty with the involvement of students and academic staff of all (undergraduate, master's, one-level and doctoral) levels of education, which will contribute to the promotion of science among young people, the implementation of students' scientific activities (research, conference reports, articles, etc.), participation in debates, in-depth discussion of issues of interest to them.
 - b) To support the production of new scientific researches at the relevant faculty in accordance with the priority research areas (medicine, education, law, architecture, psychology and others)
3. Functions and tasks of the club:
 - a) Holding of scientific events (conferences, seminars, public reports, master-classes), within the framework of which the members of the Young Researchers Club will have

the opportunity to publicly present the results of their research, improve their scientific skills, and hold a discussion about the current problems of science.

- b) Implementation of research works (research projects, etc.) and distribution of research results in society;
- c) Development of relations between students, creation and strengthening of the spirit of teamwork among club members;
- d) Close connection/communication with foreign or local similar student organizations, clubs at the club level;
- e) Promoting the involvement of students, graduates and schoolchildren in various scientific activities;

3. Club structure and administration

1. The club is headed by a president who is accountable to the club support and development board..
2. Club positions and structural units
 - a) President;
 - b) Club member;
 - c) Club mentor;
3. Rights of the club president:
 - a) He/she directs the activities of the club and is responsible for the quality management of the activities of the club;
 - b) Responsible for increasing the awareness of the club;
 - c) Contributes to the generation of ideas in the club and the effectiveness of the club;
 - d) Exercises other powers defined by this Charter;
4. The club president will be deprived of his/her authority if:
 - a) In case of violation of the present Charter and regulations of the student club;
 - b) In case of putting pressure on club members;
 - c) In case of missing 30% of the meetings for no good reason;
 - d) in case of violation of ethics norms and bylaws;
5. The president of the club is elected for a term of 2 years by the majority of votes of the total number of club members (<https://electionbuddy.com/> using the anonymous electronic voting platform).
6. Mentor of the club is an academic or visiting staff of the East European University, or a member of the elite club, who is involved in the activities of the club, helps students to prepare research projects, allows them to present the research project at any stage and receive feedback, also carries out trainings and cares about the development of presentation and communication skills of club members.
7. The schedule and agenda of meetings of scientific clubs are determined by the preliminary work plan.

4. Club membership

1. Any student or graduate of the East European University with high academic performance, motivated bachelor's, master's, one-level and doctoral programs, who is interested in scientific research and wants to deepen their knowledge in this direction, and who has at least once presented a paper at a scientific conference or published a publication, can become a member of the club;
2. The number of club members should not be less than 5 members;
3. To join the club, the interested person needs to fill in the "electronic application for joining the club" (see the link:<https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/RWT3XTN>)
5. The issue of joining the club and expulsion from the club is decided by the club, by the majority of the full membership;
6. The grounds for terminating the rights of a club member are:
 - a) gross violation of the present charter, student club regulations, research ethics and integrity, and bylaws;
 - b) Unsuccessful activity in the scientific field for 6 months;
 - c) Transfer to another higher educational institution or termination of student status;
 - d) Personal application
 - e) Absence of 50% of the meetings due to non-honorable reasons;
7. Club member rights:
 - a) to participate in the general activities of the club;
 - b) to use the information and technical means available to the club within the limits of possibilities
8. Obligations of the club member:
 - a) To follow the club charter, club regulations and decisions made by the majority of members;
 - b) to follow the norms of ethics and obey the bylaws;
 - c) actively participate in the work of the club (including attending meetings, preparing presentations and engaging in discussions, etc.);

5. Authority of the club

1. The club is authorized to:
 - a) to determine the agenda of the club's work and organize it;
 - b) implement thematic events based on the profile of the club;
 - c) In order to disseminate information about the event, provide information to the Student Club Support and Development Council 10 working days in advance;
 - d) to carry out joint scientific projects with other clubs of a similar profile;
 - e) select reports, projects to present at the conference or grant competition;
 - f) organize student discussions on various scientific issues.

- g) listen to scientific reports of club members;
- h) in agreement with the Council, to invite guest lecture to hold a public lecture, training;
- i) to select new members of the club through a competition and submit information to the council every semester;
- k) To involve graduates and students in the activities carried out by the club.
- k) to submit an annual report on the club's work to the Council; მ) დაიცვას და განახორციელოს Other functions related to the activities of the club defined by the present charter, the regulations of the student club.

6. Suspension/Cancellation of Club Authority

- a. The club is registered/cancelled by the council, based on an application filled out by the founders in the manner defined by this regulation, or if the club has violated its powers, or the club has a low rating (0-10) during the last semester. Instead of canceling the club, the board may consider changing the management team.
- b. In case of violation of the regulations of the activity of the student club, it is possible to suspend the right of activity for the club for a period of one to six months;

7. Final Provisions

- 1. The Club Support and Development Council will discuss the amendment to the charter and the issue of changing the charter based on the presentation of the club president and will submit it to the rector of the university for approval. and team members, based on the approval of the board.
- 2. The approval of the charter, making changes and additions to it is carried out by the rector of the university in accordance with the regulations of the university, the regulations of the student club and other legal acts.
- 3. The charter shall come into effect upon its approval.
